Suspected Overdose Incident Report Guidelines for Shelter Staff

DHS Incident Report must include

- 1. Date of incident
- 2. Client Name and CARES ID
- 3. Specific location client was found
- Whether client was unresponsive, or unable to wake when found
- 5. Whether client became responsive during the incident
- 6. Steps taken by staff when client was found
 - Yelled client's name
 - Said something to alert client
 - Sternal rub
- 7. If naloxone was administered
 - If yes, how many doses
 - If no, why not
- 8. What was done by Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
- 9. If client was taken to the hospital
